In June I attended a course in Schloß Drosendorf (1,5 hours-drive northwestern to Vienna) about Power Relations in NGO Work. This well-made seminar occurs each year and I recommend it strongly to everybody who gets into touch with NGO work or any kind of charity work. As in the IVA, we get more and more in touch with this theme. The seminar gives you an overlook about the main problems in charity (which are dearly tricky), and how they can be reduced/ avoided. The lecturers and participants report directly about their work in the field and are not ashamed to point out their own errors, which provides a tremendous insight. The atmosphere is very friendly, the 3-day seminar just costs about 80 Euros (food/hotel). For students and non-students / all in English.
